The Housing (Scotland) Act 2001 requires social landlords to consult tenants and take account of their views when making decisions about proposed rent increases.

Landlords' main source of income is the rents that tenants pay, and for most tenants it is also the main item of household expenditure. With this in mind, it is crucial for landlords to consult and understand current and future tenants views and priorities when considering any increase to rents they charge. This is to ensure that both tenants and landlords get the best from rent setting and rent increases.
