



TIS Best Innovative Practice Award 2018

This award recognises an outstanding innovative approach that has made a real difference to the lives of tenants, engagement of communities, and delivery of housing services at a local or national level. It will reward thinking outside of the box, invention, and creativity. Technology may be central to your application but this is not essential.

Award description

The nominee must clearly evidence a positive impact on housing services and satisfaction levels, or have improved the lives of people in the communities they work. For example, initiatives may include a new service, technology, product, or approach to a specific housing issue.

Who is eligible?

- » Local Authority
- » Registered Social Landlord

Who can make the nomination?

- » The organisation themselves
- » A member of staff from the housing organisation
- » An individual or group from the community
- » Tenant and Resident Group or Federation
- » An Elected Member or member of the Governing Body from the housing organisation
- » A local agency

How will the nomination be judged?

- » An independent judging panel will consider the nomination against the award criteria
- » Each question lists the award criteria
- » Make sure all questions are answered as fully as possible against the criteria
- » Keep your nomination concise and focused
- » Do not exceed the maximum word count – it is okay to use bullet points or lists
- » Include substantial evidence in your nomination submission
- » Submit supporting evidence if it helps to support your nomination submission
