The Frances Nelson MBE Award was introduced in recognition of our previous Chair and celebrates the commitment and hard work of an individual who has made a real difference in their community or wider area.

Award description

The nominee will be an inspirational and committed individual who has dedicated time, effort and determination to improve the lives or wellbeing of others. For example by improving the local environment; campaigning to assist a specific group; supporting others in their area etc.

Who is eligible?

- » Individual tenant or resident
- » Individual volunteer
- » Individual member of the community

Who can make the nomination?

- » The individual themselves
- » An individual from the community
- » An individual representing a group
- » A member of staff from the housing organisation
- » An Elected Member or member of the Governing Body from the housing organisation
- » A local agency

How will the nomination be judged?

- » An independent judging panel will consider the nomination against the award criteria
- » Each question lists the award criteria
- » Make sure all questions are answered as fully as possible against the criteria
- » Keep your nomination concise and focused
- » Do not exceed the maximum word count
It is okay to use bullet points or lists
- » Include substantial evidence in your nomination submission
- » Submit supporting evidence if it helps to support your nomination submission
