This award recognises an inspiring volunteer who has demonstrated an exceptional commitment to adding value to their local area and improving community spirit; strengthening relationships and communication; championing tenant participation and finding innovative new ways to get people involved; influencing decisions and housing policies, services and standards; and/or driving community regeneration projects forward.

Submissions must evidence how the individual has empowered tenants, residents, and community groups to work together, have their say, and influence decisions about housing policies, services and standards.

Desirable but not essential, the nominator is encouraged to detail how the individual utilised digital technologies to extend the reach of services, form key partnerships, and target often hard to reach groups.

Who can apply?

This award is open to an individual volunteer.

The judging process

- An independent judging panel will rate your application against the award criteria. The panel will consist of representatives from organisations across the Scottish social rented sector.
- Your award submission will provide the basis for both the shortlist and final decision of the winning entry.
- TIS welcome applications in more than one award category.
- Please ensure you answer all questions as fully as possible and keep the content of your nomination focused – avoid exceeding the suggested word count.
- Only submit supporting evidence if this provides additional and relevant information.
